The driving force behind this is the skill of public speaking. i.e. an act of delivering a speech before an audience. Public speaking involves communicating ideas and information clearly and engagingly. It is a one way interaction. So more responsibility lies on the speaker to ensure that the message is being communicated to the audience emphatically and effectively.

Broadly speaking, public speaking is undertaken for three purposes: persuasion - to change or influence the audience's belief; education - transfer of knowledge on a particular topic; entertainment - for the audience (stand-up comedy). Overall, public speaking empowers individuals to articulate ideas effectively, connect with diverse people, and contribute towards personal and social growth.
